Basic Function

To perform various types of maintenance work and grass cutting activities for Racine County Parks as required.

Essential Duties

- 1. Operate various types of Park maintenance equipment.
- 2. Perform daily routine maintenance checks on equipment.
- 3. Transport various types of equipment with truck/trailer from one project to another.
- 4. Perform other related work as required.

Supervision Received

Receives supervision from the <u>Highway Assistant Superintendent / Supervisors</u>, <u>Park Operational Supervisor</u>

Qualifications

- Possess a valid Wisconsin driver's license with a clean driving record.
- Shall be a minimum of Eighteen (18) years of age
- High school diploma or GED.
- Available for work flexible hours from the first week in May through the last week in September 2019.
- Available to work between the hours of 6 a.m. 4:00 p.m. 40 hours (not guaranteed).
- Shall have prompt and regular attendance.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities

- · Ability to carry our oral and written instructions.
- · Ability to perform work under varying outside climate conditions
- Ability to perform physical tasks.
- Ability to be conscientious, alert and focused on surroundings.
- Ability and experience operating commercial mowing equipment

Physical Qualifications

- Continuous (67-100% of workday) communicating, hearing, use of far and near vision and of exerting up to 20 pounds' force.
- Frequent (34-66% of workday) standing, walking, stooping, kneeling, crouching, climbing using legs and arms for support, balancing, bending/twisting, reaching and exerting up to 50 pounds of force.
- Occasional (1-33% of workday) sitting, crawling, and exerting up to 100 pounds of force.

Working Conditions

- Continuous (67-100% of workday) exposure to moving vehicles and mechanical hazards.
- Frequent (34-66% of workday) exposure to the outside elements and temperature changes.
- Occasional (1-33% of workday) exposure to extreme heat, wet or humid conditions, noise, vibrations; exposure to fumes, noxious odors, dust and physically confined work zone sites.

Equipment Used

Hand tools such as hammers, power tools and shovel/broom; transportation vehicles such as a pick-up, trailer, parks machinery; personal protective equipment, work boots, and hearing and eye protection; and a 2-way radio.

This description has been prepared to assist in properly evaluating various classes of responsibilities, skills, working conditions, etc., present in the classification. It is intended to indicate the kinds of tasks and characteristic levels of work difficulty that will be required of positions that will be given this title. It is not intended as a complete list of specific duties and responsibilities.
