Brian Jensen reviewed the petition and public hearing testimony using text and maps. Perry Baumann was present and indicated that they want to build a single-family home on the parcel and to answer questions of the committee. STAFF RECOMMENDATION(S)

Staff recommends approval as it is consistent with the surrounding zoning and uses, the land use is low-density residential, it is consistent with the 2035 Comprehensive Land Use Plan and as stated by the committee chairman and has received Certified Survey Map approval from the Town of Waterford and will be appearing at the Town of Waterford at their February 7, 2022 public hearing for rezone decision.

<u>Conditional Use</u> to allow outside dumpster and roll-off container storage; located in the M-3, Heavy Industrial District, at 7400 Noraire Dr.; Sec. 12, T4N, R20E, **Town of Norway** (Parcel Id. No. 010042012035150)

Jensen reviewed the petition and public hearing testimony using text and maps. In 2016, there was a conditional use approved but never executed. Andrew Raymonds, attorney for Eagle Disposal, was present. The intent is to use the whole parcel for storage. The containers currently onsite are empty. The hours of operation would be Monday through Friday, 7:00 am to 5:00 pm and Saturday 7:00 am to noon and not open on Sunday. There are no plans to erect a building.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION(S)

Staff recommends approval as the use is compatible with underlying zoning. Based on other things going on in the area, the use fits with the uses in the district. Staff would also recommend that only empty containers may be stored on the site and must be neat and orderly. It also protects the safety of people working on the site, but also for the emergency services that may have access the site. The storage containers may only be stored on approved surface such as gravel, asphalt, concrete, as to prevent dirt and/or debris to be tracked onto the roadways. If approved, the record should show that there is a penalty for starting this before approvals, which is a quadruple penalty of \$600.00.

Supervisor ROBERT GROVE MOVED, seconded by Supervisor Eckman to approve based on staff's recommended conditions. It also needs to be approved by the Town of Norway.
