

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-122

ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY SPECIAL COMMITTEE REGARDING REAPPORTIONMENT REPEALING AND RECREATING SECTION 2-26 OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SUPERVISORY DISTRICT DESIGNATION AND DESCRIPTION.

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

Part 1

Chapter 2, Article II, Division 1, Section 2-26 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

Sec. 2-26. District designation and description.

The board of supervisors shall consist of twenty-one (21) supervisors to be elected from supervisory districts which are hereby created, numbered and described as follows:

- (1) *District 1, population 9,222*

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the second, third, fourth, and seventh municipal wards.

- (2) *District 2, population 9,511*

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the fifth, sixth, twenty-seventh, and thirty-third municipal wards.

- (3) *District 3, population 9,334*

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the tenth, twelfth, eighteenth, and thirty-seventh municipal wards.

- (4) *District 4, population 9,366*

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the first, ninth, eleventh, seventeenth, and nineteenth municipal wards.

- (5) *District 5, population 9,178*

That portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the sixth and twentieth municipal wards, that portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the

4 sixth and eighth municipal wards, and that portion of the City of Racine
5 contained in the thirteenth and sixteenth municipal wards.

7 (6) *District 6, population 9,467*

9 That portion of the City of Racine contained in the eighth, fourteenth,
10 fifteenth, twentieth, twenty-first, and twenty-second municipal wards.

11
12 (7) *District 7, population 9,140*

13
14 The entire Village of Elmwood Park, that portion of the Village of Mt.
15 Pleasant contained in the twenty-second and twenty-third wards, and that
16 portion of the City of Racine contained in the twenty-fifth, twenty-sixth, and
17 twenty-ninth wards.

18
19 (8) *District 8, population 9,524*

20
21 That portion of the City of Racine contained in the twenty-eighth, thirtieth,
22 thirty-second, thirty-fifth, and thirty-sixth municipal wards.

23
24 (9) *District 9, population 9,699*

25
26 That portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the fifth municipal
27 ward and that portion of the City of Racine contained in the twenty-third,
28 twenty-fourth, thirty-first, and thirty-fourth municipal wards.

29
30 (10) *District 10, population 9,682*

31
32 The entire Village of North Bay, the entire Village of Wind Point, that portion
33 of the Village of Caledonia contained in the seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth,
34 and twelfth municipal wards, and that portion of the City of Racine contained
35 in the thirty-eighth municipal ward.

36
37 (11) *District 11, population 9,408*

38
39 That portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the first, second,
40 eleventh, seventeenth, eighteenth, nineteenth, twentieth, and twenty-first
41 municipal wards.

42
43 (12) *District 12, population 9,401*

44
45 That portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the third, fourth,
46 seventh, ninth, tenth, twelfth, and twenty-fourth municipal wards.

4 (13) *District 13, population 9,456*

5
6 The entire town of Norway and that portion of the Village of Raymond
7 contained in the fifth and sixth municipal wards.

8
9 (14) *District 14, population 9,450*

10
11 The entire Village of Sturtevant and that portion of the Village of Mt.
12 Pleasant contained in the fourteenth and fifteenth municipal wards.

13
14 (15) *District 15, population 9,371*

15
16 That portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the eleventh, thirteenth,
17 fourteenth, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth, and eighteenth municipal
18 wards.

19
20 (16) *District 16, population 9,388*

21
22 The entire Village of Union Grove, the entire Village of Yorkville, and that
23 portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the thirteenth and
24 sixteenth municipal wards.

25
26 (17) *District 17, population 9,495*

27
28 That portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the first, second, third,
29 fourth, fifth, and nineteenth municipal wards and that portion of the Village
30 of Raymond contained in the first, second, third, and fourth municipal wards.

31
32 (18) *District 18, population 9,427*

33
34 That portion of the Village of Rochester contained in the second municipal
35 ward, that portion of the Town of Dover contained in the second, third,
36 fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, and eighth municipal wards, and that portion of
37 the Village of Waterford contained in the first, second, third, sixth, seventh,
38 eighth, and ninth municipal wards.

39
40 (19) *District 19, population 9,325*

41
42 The entire Town of Waterford, that portion of the Village of Rochester
43 contained in the first, third, and fifth municipal wards, and that portion of the
44 Village of Waterford contained in the fourth and fifth municipal wards.

3
4 (20) *District 20, population 9,400*

5
6 That portion of the Town of Burlington contained in the third, fourth, fifth,
7 sixth, and seventh wards, that portion of the Town of Dover contained in the
8 first municipal ward, that portion of the Village of Rochester contained in the
9 fourth and sixth municipal wards, and that portion of the City of Burlington
10 contained in the second, sixth, seventh, and eighth municipal wards.

11
12 (21) *District 21, population 9,483*

13
14 That portion of the Town of Burlington contained in the first, second, eighth,
15 ninth, tenth, and eleventh municipal wards and that portion of the City of
16 Burlington contained in the first, third, fourth and fifth municipal wards.
