INFORMATION ONLY

WHEREAS, in July 2018 via Resolution No. 2018-37, the Racine County Board approved the Sheriff's Office acceptance of \$300,000.00 from the FBI to enhance the Robert Rohner Range training facility and construct a scenario training building; and

WHEREAS, in August 2021 via Resolution No. 2021-48, the Racine County Board approved the acceptance of \$375,000.00 from the FBI to cover the significant increase in bids associated with the project; and

WHEREAS, at that time, the FBI could not commit to allocating the funds to cover a moveable wall system but believed it would be covered in the next budget cycle; and

WHEREAS, the FBI has not allocated an additional \$205,207.00 to pay for the associated costs with moveable walls placed inside of the scenario training building; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office was advised that it must meet the following criteria to obtain the FBI funding:

- 1. Racine County must be able to accept funding related to the project in a timely manner and place any monies into an account allowing the County to control project related expenditures, and
- 2. The account established by the County must be free of restrictions as it relates to expenditure deadlines or monetary amounts; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests acceptance of the federal funds and intends to provide a detailed report showing all revenues and final expenditures to any funds received.
