Demolition of Structure at County-owned land, 1720 Taylor Avenue, City of Racine

By Resolution No. 2020-44, Racine County authorized the purchase of real property at 1720 Taylor Avenue in the City of Racine for \$290,000.00 and associated costs not to exceed \$20,000.00. That resolution noted that acquisition of the subject property is in the County's best interest and in furtherance of the facilities plan given the limited availability of Countyowned and controlled land in close proximity to the Dennis Kornwolf Service Center (i.e., Human Services Building) and the need to meet increasing demands. That resolution further noted that the subject property may serve as a suitable future location for a stand-alone behavioral health building in furtherance of the facilities plan. The closing purchase price of the subject property was \$275,000.00(reduced due to soil conditions).

Although final use of the subject property has not yet been determined, it is in the County's best interest to proceed with demolition of the existing structure. The structure is in extremely poor condition and is expected to continue deteriorating and is at-risk of potentially collapsing in the event of a significant weather event. Given the poor state of the structure, it is cost-prohibitive to further invest in upkeep and maintenance. Accordingly, I am requesting \$250,000.00 to proceed with the demolition of the building structure at 1720 Taylor Avenue in the City of Racine.
