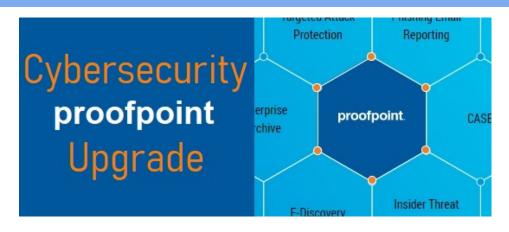

Cybersecurity



Racine County has invested in upgrading its email filtering and security awareness training to Proofpoint.

Everyone hates receiving junk email... what is worse is the junk email that looks legitimate but really isn't. Our new software upgrade to Proofpoint will result in:

- Fewer phishing emails being delivered to your Inbox.
- Improved remediation by your Cyber Team if a malicious email is delivered to your Inbox.
- Clear and more specific "email tags" to denote external emails.

Our compliance with certain federal audits requires all Racine County users to be more educated on cybersecurity. For you, this means:

- A move to **quarterly** security training versus annually.
- Training will now be shorter and more easily digestible.
- Real-life scenarios based on current events.



REMEMBER...If you receive a phishing email and report it using the **Report Message PhishAlarm** (see button to the left), it can take only 10-15 seconds for Proofpoint to remove the message from ALL other user's mailboxes!
