

IMPORTING MICROSOFT EDGE BROWSER FAVORITES



Scope

The purpose of this knowledge base (KB) document is to provide instructions on how to import your Edge favorites into another PC. This is frequently used with Computer Replacements.

Procedure



Step by step instructions

Step 0 – confirm where you saved your exported favorites. If needed send the file to yourself using email then open your Outlook, find the email you sent to yourself, and then save the exported browser favorites file to your OneDrive Documents folder

Step 1 – open Microsoft Edge



on new PC (see Figure 1)

for Settings and more at the far right (see Figure Step 2 – click on 3 dots 2)




Figure 2 – Edge 3 dots displays a menu including **Favorites**

- Step 3 select **Favorites** (see Figure 2)




Figure 3 – Favorites manager with its own 3 dots

- Step 4 click on Favorites 3 dots (yes it has its own 3 dots) (see Figure 3)




Figure 4 – menu appears highlighted Import favorites

- Step 5 click on **Import favorites** (see Figure 4)




Figure 5 – profile appears with **Import browser data** choice

- Step 6 profile appears with **Import browser data** choice (see Figure 5)




Figure 6 – click on > to right of Import browser data choice

- Step 7 click on > symbol to the right of Import browser data selection (see Figure 6)
- Step 8 select **Choose what to Import** (see Figure 7)






Figure 8 – Import browser data menu appears

- Step 9 Import browser data menu appears (see Figure 8)




Figure 9 – Import from drop down - select Favorites or bookmarks HTML file

- Step 10 Import from drop down select Favorites or bookmarks HTML file (see Figure 9)
- Step 11 click on **Choose file** (see Figure 10)




Figure 11 – select saved favorites file from selected folder

- Step 12 select file and click **Open** (see Figure 11)





Figure 12 - old bookmarks now appear in Microsoft Edge on the new PC

- Step 13 Edge will now show your old Favorites (see Figure 12)



Step 14 – change your Edge settings to display the favorites bar (see Figure 13)
