

SETTING WEB PAGES TO OPEN IN MICROSOFT EDGE BROWSER AT START UP

Scope

The purpose of this knowledge base (KB) document is to provide instructions on how to setup which websites open automatically each time you start up your PC and Edge browser.

Procedure



Open Edge on your PC. Ideally, open each of your favorite websites in advance – then follow this procedure.

Step by step instructions

Step 1 – open **Edge** browser (see Figure 1)




Figure 2 – Edge 3 dots which is **Settings and more** (Alt+F)

Step 2 – click on 3 dots at far right  which is **Settings and more (Alt + F)** (see Figure 2)




Figure 3 – Settings menu

Step 3 – click on **Settings** (see Figure 3)




Figure 4 – **Settings** menu appears – select **Start, home and new tabs** option

Step 4 – **Settings** menu appears - select **Start, home and new tabs** option (see Figure 4)




Figure 5 – Open tabs from the previous session

Step 5 – click on **Open tabs from the previous session** (see Figure 5) and/or




Figure 6 – Open these pages – Add a new page

Step 6 – click on **Open these pages – Add a new page** (see Figure 6)
