WHEREAS, the specialized transportation dollars must be used for transportation related to individuals with a disability; and

WHEREAS, the trust fund dollars are for purchase and maintenance of vehicles used for specialized transportation; and

WHEREAS, the total cost includes the installation of a Plexiglass partition between the driver and the back seat.
