7 profit organization that connects youth in Racine County with adult mentors; and

9 **WHEREAS**, as part of the City of Racine's ARPA Violence Reduction Initiatives
10 application process and given our administrative and fiscal capacity, this organization has
11 requested that Racine County serve as the fiscal agent for this application; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the proposal that will be submitted for these funds is for the evidence-based
14 practice of Community-based Mentorship that will provide one-to-one mentoring for youth ages
15 6-17; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the goal of this mentor relationship is to become a positive role model for
18 youth that may not have one in their lives; and

20 **WHEREAS**, this program will focus on relationships between volunteers and
21 underserved and/or at-risk youth that live in the city of Racine; and

23 **WHEREAS**, programs such as these show improved outcomes related to academic
24 achievement, graduation rates, youth delinquency, self-confidence and self-esteem to name a
25 few; and

27 **WHEREAS**, Racine County's role as fiscal agent will be to process invoices and serve
28 as the recipient of the ARPA funds to then be allocated to the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Racine
29 and Kenosha Counties; and

31 **WHEREAS**, Racine County will receive a nominal percentage for administrative cost.
