**WHEREAS**, Racine County received \$38 million in ARPA funds which can be used on sewer and clean water infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, Eagle Lake Sewer Utility District, Western Racine County Sewerage District, and Browns Lake Sanitary District were created under WI statute 200 and did not receive ARPA funds; and

**WHEREAS**, each district made a request to the ARPA advisory committee which approved \$750,000 for these projects to be prorated based on the size of their projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Racine County's contribution will be matched by local funds, district reserves, and potential Clean Water Fund loans.
