6 **WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2022, Ms. Polzin was entering the courthouse to appear for
7 a case in which she was subpoenaed; and

10 the courthouse; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Polzin is not sure if she slipped on ice or the salt that was put down to
13 prevent it; and

15 **WHEREAS**, an ambulance was called and Ms. Polzin was taken to the hospital; and

17 **WHEREAS**, as a result of the fall, Ms. Polzin suffered a broken nose, broken glasses
18 and received 4 stiches on her left eye;

20 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Polzin is requesting reimbursement for her expenses from the incident
21 totaling \$485 (eyeglasses - \$260.00 and the rescue squad - \$225.00) and additional pain and
22 suffering; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Office of Corporation Counsel and Buildings and Facilities have
25 investigated this claim and recommend denial.
