Ms. Goggins provided the following updates on HSD's evaluations of the potential properties provided to HSD by Ms. Christman, and HSD's other efforts to identify suitable housing for the pending parties:

October: 709 properties were referred to HSD for evaluation, of which only 96 had not been previously evaluated by HSD for conformity with statutory criteria. Of those 96 properties, 70 met statutory criteria after HSD's preliminary evaluation using the digital mapping tool. Forty-nine of the

70 properties exceeded the amount of all the participating vendors' preferred purchase prices for residential properties (maximum amount of \$350,000), so the remaining 21 properties were sent to vendors for consideration. One vendor did make an offer on one of the locations, however, the vendor was not the accepted offer.
