	WHEREAS, it is the vision of TLC to ensure homeless persons in Western Racine
	County have access to safe shelter and services as they transition back into the community;
	and
	WHEREAS, in 2004, TLC entered into an agreement with non-profit Love, Inc. to util
	the space above Love, Inc. and use donor funds to build a 3000 square foot shelter in
	Burlington that accommodated 16 individuals per night; and
	MULTIPLAC TIC and Lava Inched a large agreement for the past 17 years but in
	WHEREAS, TLC and Love, Inc had a lease agreement for the past 17 years but, in September of 2021, Love, Inc notified TLC that the lease would not be extended past July 1,
	2022t; and
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	WHEREAS, after months of looking for new space, TLC entered into a lease agreem
	with the Women's Resource Center (WRC) to occupy a building WRC owned in Kansasville
	and
	WHEREAS, TLC spent their own limited financial resources for building upgrades bu
	the expenses for the roof and furnaces have exceeded their available funds; and
	WHEREAS, unfortunately, the condition of the roof and furnace will no longer allow f
	deferred maintenance and there is significant leaking which is causing damage to the ceiling
	walls, and floors in several of the rooms; and
	WHEREAS, the furnaces are original to the building and after extensive consult, it has
	been deemed that repairs will not fix the issues and replacement is necessary; and
	WHEREAS, TLC views this new space as one that will be long term and feels invest
	in installing a new roof and updating the furnaces will not only benefit the longevity of the
	building but will allow TLC to continue to house the homeless; and
	WHEREAS, TLC is the only homeless shelter in Western Racine County and is a vita
	service to our most vulnerable residents.
