WHEREAS, Fentanyl and other illicit drugs have had a devastating impact on Racine County and southeastern Wisconsin, leading to an alarming increase in overdose deaths, hospitalizations, and a rise in drug-related crime; and

WHEREAS, the opioid epidemic has affected individuals and families from all walks of life and has put a strain on public health and law enforcement resources; and

WHEREAS, this request is to purchase three handheld narcotics analyzers to support our law enforcement personnel as they combat the scourge of synthetic fentanyl in our community; and

WHEREAS, as these illicit drugs enter our county, the ability to quickly and accurately identify them has become increasingly important; and

WHEREAS, these state-of-the-art devices allow for quick and non-invasive identification of drugs in the field; and

WHEREAS, the device is portable, easy to use, and provides reliable and accurate results in seconds; and

WHEREAS, with this technology, our deputies will be able to make informed decisions about how to safely and effectively handle potentially dangerous situations; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of three handheld narcotics analyzers is an investment in the safety of our community and the health and safety of our residents and law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, this investment would position Racine County as an innovator and trailblazer as we would be the first in the state to provide this state-of-the-art technology to our law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the approximate cost of this equipment and necessary software is \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that we make an allocation from our opioid settlement funds to purchase these devices as soon as possible.
