**WHEREAS**, this Title III ARPA grant is for the period October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2024 and will be used as follows:

- C-1 Congregate Meal Sites The additional funds will be used to cover supplies and additional food costs to re-open meal sites. Funds will also be used to cover the staff costs of a Registered Dietetic Technician as well as shelf-stable food for all congregate participants; and
- C-2 Home Delivered Meals Funds will be used to cover additional meals for the growing number of participants that sign up for the program. Funds also cover staff expenses and shelf-stable meals for all homebound participants. Funds will also be used to pay for a new ServTracker Mobile Meals app which assists in the streamlining of the meal delivery process and makes participant emergency contact calls more efficient; and
- 3-B Supportive Services Funds will be used to cover costs of new evidence-based classes for older adults entitled "Eat Smart, Move More, Weigh Less". Funds will also be used to cover staff costs for a bi-lingual, bi-cultural caregiver support staff member; and
- 3-D Prevention Funds will be used to cover advertisement costs of the new evidence-based class entitled "Eat Smart, Move More, Weigh Less"; and
- 3-E Family Caregiver Support funds will be used to pay for short-term temporary respite for family caregivers who need a break from their caregiving duties.

- C-2 Home Delivered Meals Funds will be used to cover additional meals for the growing number of participants that sign up for the program. Funds also cover staff expenses and shelf-stable meals for all homebound participants. Funds will also be used to pay for a new ServTracker Mobile Meals app which assists in the streamlining of the meal delivery process and makes participant emergency contact calls more efficient.
