

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-7

ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY SPECIAL COMMITTEE REGARDING REAPPORTIONMENT AMENDING SECTION 2-26 OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SUPERVISORY DISTRICT DESIGNATION AND DESCRIPTION.

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

Chapter 2, Article II, Division 1, Section 26 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-26. District designation and description.

The board of supervisors shall consist of twenty-one (21) supervisors to be elected from supervisory districts which are hereby created, numbered and described as follows:

- (1) District 1, population 9,222

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the second, third, fourth, and seventh municipal wards.

- (2) District 2, population 9,511

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the fifth, sixth, thirty-fourth, and forty-fifth municipal wards.

- (3) District 3, population 9,334

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the tenth, twelfth, nineteenth, twentieth, and twenty-first municipal wards.

- (4) District 4, population 9,366

That portion of the City of Racine contained in the first, ninth, eleventh, eighteenth, and twenty-third municipal wards.

- (5) District 5, population 9,178

That portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the sixth and twentieth municipal wards, that portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the

4 sixth and eighth municipal wards, and that portion of the City of Racine
5 contained in the thirteenth and seventeenth municipal wards.

7 (6) *District 6, population 9,467*

9 That portion of the City of Racine contained in the eighth, fourteenth,
10 fifteenth, sixteenth, twenty-fourth, twenty-fifth, and twenty-sixth municipal
11 wards.

12
13 (7) *District 7, population 9,140*

14
15 The entire Village of Elmwood Park, that portion of the Village of Mt.
16 Pleasant contained in the twenty-second, twenty-third and twenty-fourth
17 wards, and that portion of the City of Racine contained in the twenty-ninth,
18 thirtieth, thirty-first, and thirty-second wards.

19
20 (8) *District 8, population 9,524*

21
22 That portion of the City of Racine contained in the thirty-third, thirty-fifth,
23 thirty-sixth, thirty-seventh, thirty-eighth, thirty-ninth, fortieth, forty-eighth,
24 and forty-ninth municipal wards.

25
26 (9) *District 9, population 9,699*

27
28 That portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the fifth municipal
29 ward and that portion of the City of Racine contained in the twenty-seventh,
30 twenty-eighth, forty-first, forty-second, forty-third, forty-fourth, forty-sixth,
31 and forty-seventh municipal wards.

32
33 (10) *District 10, population 9,682*

34
35 The entire Village of North Bay, the entire Village of Wind Point, that portion
36 of the Village of Caledonia contained in the seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth,
37 and twelfth municipal wards, and that portion of the City of Racine contained
38 in the twenty-second municipal ward.

39
40 (11) *District 11, population 9,408*

41
42 That portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the first, second,
43 eleventh, seventeenth, eighteenth, nineteenth, twentieth, twenty-first, and
44 twenty-fifth municipal wards.

4 (12) *District 12, population 9,401*

5
6 That portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the third, fourth,
7 seventh, ninth, tenth, and twelfth municipal wards.

8
9 (13) *District 13, population 9,456*

10
11 The entire town of Norway and that portion of the Village of Raymond
12 contained in the fifth and sixth municipal wards.

13
14 (14) *District 14, population 9,450*

15
16 The entire Village of Sturtevant and that portion of the Village of Mt.
17 Pleasant contained in the fourteenth and fifteenth municipal wards.

18
19 (15) *District 15, population 9,371*

20
21 That portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the eleventh, thirteenth,
22 fourteenth, fifteenth, sixteenth, seventeenth, and eighteenth municipal
23 wards.

24
25 (16) *District 16, population 9,388*

26
27 The entire Village of Union Grove, the entire Village of Yorkville, and that
28 portion of the Village of Mt. Pleasant contained in the thirteenth and
29 sixteenth municipal wards.

30
31 (17) *District 17, population 9,495*

32
33 That portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the first, second, third,
34 fourth, fifth, and nineteenth municipal wards and that portion of the Village
35 of Raymond contained in the first, second, third, and fourth municipal wards.

36
37 (18) *District 18, population 9,427*

38
39 That portion of the Village of Rochester contained in the second municipal
40 ward, that portion of the Town of Dover contained in the second, third,
41 fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, and eighth municipal wards, and that portion of
42 the Village of Waterford contained in the first, second, third, sixth, seventh,
43 eighth, and ninth municipal wards.

4 (19) *District 19, population 9,325*

5
6 The entire Town of Waterford, that portion of the Village of Rochester
7 contained in the first, third, and fifth municipal wards, and that portion of the
8 Village of Waterford contained in the fourth and fifth municipal wards.
9

10 (20) *District 20, population 9,400*

11
12 That portion of the Town of Burlington contained in the third, fourth, fifth,
13 sixth, and seventh wards, that portion of the Town of Dover contained in the
14 first municipal ward, that portion of the Village of Rochester contained in the
15 fourth and sixth municipal wards, and that portion of the City of Burlington
16 contained in the second, sixth, seventh, and eighth municipal wards.
17

18 (21) *District 21, population 9,483*

19
20 That portion of the Town of Burlington contained in the first, second, eighth,
21 ninth, tenth, and eleventh municipal wards and that portion of the City of
22 Burlington contained in the first, third, fourth and fifth municipal wards.
