20 Safety (BOTS) has notified Racine County that it is eligible to participate in the
21 Comprehensive Alcohol Risk Reduction (CARD) grant in the amount of \$5,000; and

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23 **WHEREAS**, the grant objective is to decrease the high number of alcohol related
24 vehicle accidents involving young people by reducing the sale and consumption of alcohol
25 to minors; and

28 laws among establishments, outreach to area schools and coordination with Focus on
29 Community coalition; and
