WHEREAS, Erie Insurance has filed a claim with Racine County on behalf of its insureds, Paul and Kerrie McCullough in the amount of \$1,206.99 for damage caused to their 2011 Kia Soul after it allegedly hit a series of potholes while traveling in the right lane of Highway MM near Northwestern Avenue on February 19, 2014; and

WHEREAS, after the passage of 2011 WI ACT 132, the County has the discretionary act immunity provided in Wis. Stat. Sec. 893.80(4) in addition to any standard negligence defenses; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Public Works Department have investigated this claim and recommend denial.
