WHEREAS, Annie Howell has filed a claim with Racine County in the amount of \$246.66 for damage caused to her 2012 Buick Verano after it allegedly hit a piece of loose cement from a pothole while traveling right on to Wood Road off of eastbound Durand Avenue on February 24, 2014; and

WHEREAS, after the passage of 2011 WI ACT 132, the County has the discretionary act immunity provided in Wis. Stat. Sec. 893.80(4) in addition to any standard negligence defenses; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Public Works Department have investigated this claim and recommend denial.
