WHEREAS, Racine County currently has 20 Child Support Specialists positions and two (2) of these positions have more detail-oriented job duties that require additional training and expertise; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Specialists are responsible for entering court orders, processing employer income withholdings, adjusting balances, and financial case management; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Specialist works a complex caseload that requires interaction with jurisdictions in many other states and even other countries; and

WHEREAS, over the last several years, these specialized positions have become increasingly difficult to fill due to the additional demands of the position; and

WHEREAS, by providing these specialized positions with an increased wage, Racine County will be able to recognize the additional work that these positions require; and

WHEREAS, this will allow the Child Support Division to better retain current employees and the positions will be more attractive to qualified staff when there are vacancies; and

WHEREAS, these new pay grades will also provide employees with the opportunity to be promoted and grow withing the Child Support Division when vacancies arise.
