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RESOLUTION BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING RACINE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A NEW FIVE-YEAR COOPERATIVE SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE WILDLIFE CROP DAMAGE PROGRAM

TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County is authorized to enter into a new five-year cooperative service agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the United States Department of Agriculture, that is attached hereto as *Exhibit A* and is on file in the County Clerk's Office, to participate in a damage abatement and claims program for damage done by black bears, cougars, white-tailed deer, elk, Canada geese, wild turkeys, and sandhill cranes in Racine County on agricultural lands, which agreement shall contain the following provisions:

- That the County shall not be required to provide any funds for said program or 1. project and will administer funds from the State of Wisconsin or the federal government.
- 2. That the program is contingent on funding from the state and federal agencies.
- 3. That the County shall administer the program and that the management of the program is hereby delegated to the Racine County Land & Water Conservation Committee (subcommittee of EDLUP committee).
- 4. That the United States Department of Agriculture and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources shall set the rules and requirements for any claims for damage to agricultural land.
- 5. Such other terms and conditions as the Corporation Counsel deems appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County hereby authorizes continuation in the Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County is authorized to enter into permanent fence contracts pursuant to said contract.
