RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A TREATMENT ALTERNATIVES AND DIVERSION (TAD) PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$92,494.00 FROM THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ) AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN THE ALTERNATIVES TO INCARCERATION – DRUG COURT 2014 BUDGET, 25% MATCHING FUNDS OF \$31,024.00 WILL BE SUPPLIED BY IN-KIND PROBATION SUPERVISION SERVICES BY WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County is hereby authorized to accept a Treatment and Alternatives (TAD) Program Grant in the amount of \$92,494.00 from the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto is authorized and approved within the Alternatives to Incarceration – Drug Court 2014 budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that all agreements shall incorporate such terms and conditions as the Corporation Counsel and the Finance Director deem necessary and appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

28 Diversion (TAD) grant in the amount of \$92,494.00 by the Department of Justice (DOJ), to
29 enhance Racine County's AODA Treatment Court; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Alcohol and Drug Treatment Court serves non-
32 violent, chemically dependent offenders, therefore reducing recidivism and incarceration
33 rates of this population; and

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35 **WHEREAS**, this grant will enhance the current court by increasing the number of
36 random drug tests, provide staff development training and evaluation and data
37 management service; and

39 **WHEREAS**, acceptance of this grant is in the interest of Racine County and fully
40 consistent with our criminal justice efforts to provide positive outcomes for chemically
41 dependent participants; and

43 **WHEREAS**, there is a 25% match required to be supplied by In-kind probation
44 agent services provided by the WI Department of Corrections and treatment court drug
45 testing provided by ZCI & Associates, Inc.
