

Highway Permit Fees

Highway permit petitioners must pay a fee to the County of Racine corresponding to each highway permit petition *See RACINE, WIS., COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES § 16.146 (b)(3)(2024)*.

If the County of Racine cannot permit the work described by the petition then, the petitioner will receive a fee refund. If the petitioner modifies the petition to comply with requirements and reapplies then, the petitioner will not pay an additional fee.

Attach the fee payment to each facility permit petition. Remit the permit fee in the form of a check or money order payable to: *The County of Racine*.

WisDOT (except mega-load)	3-days or more	\$100.00
WisDOT (except mega-load)	Less than 3-days	\$200.00
WisDOT (mega-load) -or- Municipal Including Racine County	Please provide at least 60-days lead time for mega-load permits. Similarly, please provide at least 60-days lead time for permits administered independently of WisDOT.	Fee varies to compensate for any required Engineering Services.
