## **INFORMATION ONLY**

WHEREAS, Racine County Sheriff's Office Boat 1, which is utilized for water safety patrol on Lake Michigan, has experienced a critical mechanical failure within the in-board diesel engines; and

**WHEREAS**, Racine County mechanics from both the Sheriff's Office and County Highway have determined that the best course of action would be to have the engines inspected by a mechanic at Rivers End Marina who has expertise in these engines; and

**WHEREAS**, a basic repair was estimated at \$15,604, however, this was considered a band-aid to failing engines that were rebuilt in 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the recommendation is for a replacement for both engines, which totals \$44,121.76; and

**WHEREAS**, the repair/replacement of the engines has been approved for reimbursement by the DNR over five years.
