LOCAL ROAD MAINTENANCE BUDGET.

To the Honorable members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

**WHEREAS**, on January 26, 2024, the State of Wisconsin had a forecasted budget surplus of \$3.25 billion.

**WHEREAS**, the state Routine Maintenance Agreement (RMA) budget increased by only 1.51% since the 2019 biennium budget from \$376,733,000 to \$382,430,200 in the 2023 biennium budget.

RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS, AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE IN

SUPPORT OF URGING THE WISCONSIN STATE LEGISLATURE TO INCREASE THE

**WHEREAS**, in 2023 WisDOT instructed Racine County to halt further spending of the Routine Maintenance budget due to winter weather expenditures throughout the state.

**WHEREAS**, Racine County's Highway Operations schedule and budget were negatively affected due to WisDOT's directive to cease Routine Maintenance spending.

**WHEREAS**, the bureau of Highway Maintenance has added 10% inflation to the equipment rate calculation due to the cost to procure equipment.

**WHEREAS**, the RMA, which funds the equipment rates, has not received adequate funding to absorb the increase.

**WHEREAS**, inadequate funding for RMA has resulted in further limiting of projects.

**WHEREAS**, the insufficient funding will cause deferred maintenance on roadways which will result in infrastructure failure and more expensive future projects.

**WHEREAS**, without additional state funds for road maintenance, the county may need to further reduce the number of projects that can be completed.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Racine County Board of Supervisors, in an effort to assist the Wisconsin Counties Highway Association and the Wisconsin Counties Association, support the request for additional funding through budgetary surplus with said funding allocated to the county routine maintenance fund.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be sent to Governor Tony Evers, all members of the State Legislature representing Racine County, the Wisconsin Counties Association, and all other Wisconsin Counties.
