7. Presentation by the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers (ACOE) regarding the results of the 6:08 Integrated Feasibility Report and Environmental Assessment (IFR/EA) of the Horlick Dam

Representatives from the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers presented results of a feasibility report and environment assessment of the Horlick Dam. Problems identified by the ACOE resulted in the recommendation of the full removal of the dam within a three-year construction period. Alternative options were screened but were deemed not viable.

Some benefits of dam removal, per ACOE included Ecosystem restoration, increased fish passage, water quality improvements, reducing flood risk, and long-term cost savings.

Invasive species, real estate requirements and plantings were reviewed. An implementation schedule was provided. Questions from the committee were answered by the representatives from the ACOE and the DNR.

Members of the Racine County Public Works Committee,

The Village of Mount Pleasant's Tourism Commission has sponsored a one-day bicycle race (Tour of America's Dairyland) on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, in the southwest portion of the Village of Mount Pleasant.

The planned course is CTH KR westbound from CTH H to Wisconn Valley Way. It will then go north on Wisconn Valley Way to Braun Rd. From Braun Rd, it travels eastbound to CTH H and then south on CTH H. This will complete a circle around the Foxconn property.

We have submitted permits to WiDOT to completely close CTH KR westbound from CTH H and Wisconn Valley Way/STH 311 from CTH KR to Braun Road. Those permits, along with our detoured route, have been approved. The Village of Mount Pleasant has approved the closure of Braun Rd from Wisconsin Valley Way to CTH H. For the course to be complete, we have submitted a permit with Racine County to completely close southbound CTH H to southbound traffic from Braun Road.

The approved detour for CTH KR will have traffic travel northbound on CTH H to Braun Rd. Traffic would then travel westbound on Braun Rd to the E. Frontage Rd. The Village of Mount Pleasant has approved the use of Braun Road for the traffic detour. All southbound traffic on CTH H north of Braun Road will be detoured to travel westbound on Braun Road to the E. Frontage Road.

Intersection Design - WisDOT HSIP Project 2803-03-01/71

Engineering is requesting the approval of a Transportation Project Plat for the design of the CTH U and CTH G roundabout project. The project is part of the WisDOT HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program), where WisDOT agrees to fund a portion of the project and oversee construction using federal funds. WisDOT funding was applied for and awarded in 2021 and a SMA (State/Municipal Agreement) was approved by the County Board (Resolution 2020-100).

WisDOT has reviewed the Transportation Project Plat which identifies additional ROW procurement required for the project to expand the intersection for the roundabout design. As such, the County is required to purchase real estate for the Right of Way and has a contract with Corre, Inc. to undertake the task of acquiring the required land. Engineering has funds available in the approved 2023 County Budget from Resolution 2023-45 to Purchase the required land interests in the 33460000.489000.24B14 account.

At this time, we are requesting the approval of the Transportation Project Plat which will allow us to begin real estate work and keep the project on schedule.
