To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Town of Waterford Land Use Map of the document entitled "SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 301, A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Racine County: 2035", adopted by the Racine County Board of Supervisors on October 13, 2009, by enactment of Ordinance No. 2009-66.

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Racine ordains as follows:

Amend the Town of Waterford Land Use Map of the "SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 301, A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Racine County: 2035" to change the land use plan designation of parcel located on the southwest corner of E. River Bay Road and Big Bend Road (STH 164), parcel identification number 016041913095020, located in part of the Southwest ¼ of Section 13, Town 4 North, Range 19 East, in the Town of Waterford, County of Racine, from Low-Density Residential (40,000 s.f. to 1.49 acres per dwelling unit) and Primary Environmental Corridor to Other Agricultural, Rural Residential and Open Land and Primary Environmental Corridor, as described in Exhibit A attached hereto.
