

 ORDINANCE NO. 2024-41

ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE CREATING SECTION 20-1801 OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON THE CONSIDERATION AND/OR ISSUANCE OF ZONING PERMITS, CONDITONAL USE AND/OR SITE PLAN REVIEW ZONING APPROVALS FOR SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS (SES)

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors does hereby ordain as follows:

Sec. 20-1801 Moratorium.

- (a) **Findings to establish a Moratorium.** A public hearing was held on July 15, 2024 and based upon that hearing, the Racine County Board of Supervisors does find as follows:
 - (1) Racine County currently has no ordinance providing guidance and regulation on the siting, development, and construction of Solar Energy Systems; and concerns were discussed at the public hearing regarding the protection of health and safety of residents and the natural environment of Racine County; and
 - (2) There is interest in establishing regulation of Solar Energy Systems in Racine County; and
 - (3) There exist potential health, safety, and environmental issues related to the construction of solar energy systems including, but not limited to electrical connections, electric and magnetic fields, structure failure, decommissioning, loss or damage to agricultural lands, and chemical exposure; and
 - (4) A moratorium on the consideration and/or issuance of zoning permits, conditional use and/or site plan review zoning approvals for Solar Energy Systems is necessary to allow the Public Works and Development Services Department and the Racine County Economic Development and Land Use Planning Committee to study how the zoning ordinance should be changed to address developments in the law while still protecting the public health, safety and general welfare of Racine County residents, visitors and the natural environment.

- (b) **Declaration of Moratorium and Exclusions.** Based upon the findings of sec. 20-1801(a), a moratorium is hereby declared with respect to the acceptance of applications for and the issuance of any zoning permits, conditional use and/or site plan review zoning approvals as described in the Racine County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20 and Wis. Stat. §§ 66.0401 and 66.0403.
- (c) **Duration of Moratorium.** This moratorium shall be in effect for nine (9) months following the effective date of this ordinance or until such time as a Solar Energy Systems ordinance is adopted and takes effect, whichever is earlier.
- (d) **Direction to Develop Revised Ordinance.** During the period of this moratorium, the Public Works and Development Services Department is directed to draft an ordinance providing comprehensive regulation of Solar Energy Systems to protect the health, safety and general welfare of the public and natural environment and that aligns with current legal requirements as part of the County's comprehensive plan. The ordinance shall be presented to the Racine County Board of Supervisors on the earliest possible date. It is the intention of the Board of Supervisors to adopt an ordinance prior to the expiration of this moratorium.
- (e) **Subjects for Consideration.** In preparing a revised ordinance, the Public Works and Development Services Department and the Economic Development and Land Use Planning Committee shall review Chapter 20, Zoning, of the Racine County Code of Ordinances, Wis. Stat. §§ 66.0401 and 66.0403, consider available studies and information concerning the potential health, safety and environmental issues related to the construction of Solar Energy Systems in Racine County, consult with legal counsel, solicit input from appropriate county staff, and interested members of the general public, and review any other information the Economic Development and Land Use Planning Committee deems appropriate.
- (f) **Severability.** If a section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- (g) **Construction.** If the provisions of this ordinance are found to be inconsistent with other provisions of the Racine County Code of Ordinances, this ordinance is deemed to control.

The Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit duplicate copies of this ordinance to all Racine County municipalities within seven (7) days after this ordinance is adopted.
