Referral to T.A.S.C. THC Alternative Solutions Class

The Racine County THC Alternative Solutions Class is a collaboration between the Racine County District Attorney's office and the Behavioral Health Services of Racine County. The District Attorney's office will refer appropriate individuals who have been charged for the first time with Possession of THC or Possession of THC Drug Paraphernalia, to T.A.S.C. Upon successful completion of T.A.S.C., charges will be dismissed, with prejudice. Referral is entirely at the discretion of the DA's Office and only individuals referred by the DA's Office will be allowed to participate in T.A.S.C. Individuals will only be given one chance to participate, and should be aware that T.A.S.C. is a voluntary program. A defendant who wishes to take advantage of this offer must be enrolled in the class within 120 days of the day this referral was signed by the DA's office or else the referral is revoked.

Behavioral Health Services (BHS) will utilize the Prime for Life curriculum as a basis for the T.A.S.C. T.A.S.C. will run 3 weeks with two classes/week. Each class will last two hours. Participants will be required to attend all sessions of classroom work, complete all assigned workbook exercises and participate in discussions. BHS will issue a certificate of completion to individuals and report to the DA's Office. BHS will report to the DA's Office any individuals that do not comply with the program. The program requires clean, or declining drug tests, while on bond in order to successfully complete the program. Compliance with the program shall be entirely within the discretion of BHS and the DA's office. There is no appeal process for discharge.

Cost of the class: \$350 fee must be paid to Behavioral Health Services of Racine County *before* the first class of a session to be able to start. This is non-refundable, and can be paid by cash, check, credit or debit.
