 **ORDINANCE NO. 2010-143** 

## ORDINANCE BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AMENDING SECTION 14-73 OF CHAPTER 14. ARTICLE III OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO CONTROL OF DOGS

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors do ordain as follows:

Section 14-73 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to "control of dogs" is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Sec. 14-73. Control of dogs.

No person shall suffer or permit his dog to be in or upon any county park or recreational area at any time except for Sanders Park, Cliffside Park, Harbor Park and the Karen A. Nelson Dog Park at Quarry Lake Park where dogs shall be permitted in designated areas only and on the bicycle trails but as permitted in this ordinance. All posted rules pertaining to handlers responsibilities shall be strictly enforced. Dogs shall be allowed on the Racine County bicycle trails but no person shall suffer or permit his dog to be on said trails unless:

- (1) Said dog is on a leash of suitable strength not more than six (6) feet in length.
- (2) Said person must have on his or her possession means or items capable of removing deposits of fecal material.
- (3) That if a dog deposits any fecal material, said person must pick up, properly wrap and remove said fecal material to an appropriate container.
- (4) All dogs must be properly licensed.
