5 **ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**
6 **FOR RACINE COUNTY: 2035**

8 **The County Board of Racine County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:**

10 **Section 1.** Pursuant to Section 59.69 (2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, Racine County is
11 authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001 (1) (a) and
12 66.1001 (2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

13
14 **Section 2.** The County Board of Racine County, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures
15 designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as
16 required by Section 66.1001 (4) (a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

18 **Section 3.** Racine County has duly noticed a public hearing on the comprehensive plan and the
19 Economic Development and Land Use Planning Committee held the public hearing, in accordance
20 with Section 66.1001(4) (d) of the Statutes.

22 **Section 4.** The Racine County Economic Development and Land Use Planning Committee, by a
23 majority vote of the entire committee, has adopted a resolution recommending to the County Board
24 the adoption of the document entitled *SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 301, A*
25 *Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for Racine County: 2035.*

27 **Section 5.** The Racine County Board does, by the enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the
28 document entitled *SEWRPC Community Assistance Planning Report No. 301, A Multi-Jurisdictional*
29 *Comprehensive Plan for Racine County: 2035*, pursuant to Section 66.1001 (4) (c) of the Wisconsin
30 Statutes.

32 **Section 6.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect
33 of the County Board and publication as required by law.
