#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2009-95**

ORDINANCE BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS IN CHAPTER 2 OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

### Part 1

Section 2-245 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to boards and committees is hereby amended to read as follows

#### Sec. 2-245. Powers of board of trustees.

Pursuant to W.S.A. § 59.03(1), the powers and duties of the board of trustees under the authority of W.S.A. § 46.18, are hereby re-authorized in regard to the Ridgewood Care Center as follows:

(1) The responsibility for the day-to-day administration of Ridgewood Care Center is hereby placed with the Ridgewood Care Center administrator, who shall report to the human services director.

 (2) The day-to-day supervisory function of Ridgewood Care Center is hereby placed with the county executive pursuant to W.S.A. § 59.17, in the same manner that the county executive is responsible for all other county departments <a href="mailto:and-subordinate units">and subordinate units</a>. The administrator of the Ridgewood Care Center shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the county board.

(3) All other powers and duties of the board of trustees shall reside in the health and human development committee and all matters pertaining to Ridgewood Care Center shall be referred to the health and human development committee of the county board.

# Part 2

Section 2-266 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to departments is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### Sec. 2-266. Created.

The following departments are created for Racine County and shall be under the direction and supervision of their respective department heads who shall be under the direction and supervision of the county executive:

(1) The finance department which shall include the office of auditor and the purchasing division.

(2) The human resources department.

(3) The information systems department which shall include the mail room/print shop division.

(4) The corporation counsel's office.

(5) The public works department which shall include the parks division, the building and facilities division, and the highway division.

(6) The human services department which shall include a youth and family division, an adult services division, an economic support division, an operations division, a workforce development division, a fiscal division, the Ridgewood Care Center, and a veterans service office.

(7) The planning and development department which shall include a planning division and the land conservation division and shall include the land information office.

(8) The county school office which is officially the children with disabilities education district.

(9) Ridgewood Health Care Center department which shall include the Racine County health officer.

(10) (9) The community services department which shall include the emergency management office and the medical examiner's office.

## Part 3

Section 2-276 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to the Human Services Department is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### Sec. 2-276. Human services.

There shall be a human services department which shall have the powers, duties and functions as set forth in this ordinance and W.S.A., ch. 46. The human services department shall provide social services to people in the areas of mental illness treatment; developmental disabilities services; income maintenance; alcohol and drug abuse services; services to children, youth and delinquents, including the operation of a secured detention facility; and long-term support services to the elderly, and physically disabled population. To carry out the duties and responsibilities of W.S.A., ch. 46, the human services department is composed of six (6) seven (7) divisions: youth and family; adult services; economic support; operations; fiscal; Ridgewood Care Center; and workforce development. In addition, the human services department shall, as authorized by the board of supervisors, administer federal and state funded employment and training programs and public welfare programs and operate the workforce development center. The human services director shall be in charge of the human services department and shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors. The human services director shall also be the county's liaison with the U.W. extension office. The human services department shall include the veterans service office which shall report to the workforce development division manager. The powers and duties of the powers and duties of the veterans service officer shall include those set forth in W.S.A., ch. 45, and this Code. Pursuant to W.S.A., ch. 45, the veterans service officer shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors. The human services department shall include the Ridgewood Care Center, a skilled nursing facility licensed by the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services. The purpose of Ridgewood Care Center is to provide skilled nursing care to Racine County residents who have need of a skilled nursing facility. There shall be an administrator of Ridgewood Care Center who shall be in charge of the center, shall report to the human services director, and shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors.
