ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE TO REZONE FROM A-1 GENERAL FARMING DISTRICT I TO A-2 GENERAL FARMING & RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT II

SECTION 4, T3N, R21E, TOWN OF YORKVILLE

APPLICANT: DAVE CALLEWAERT

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND that Certain Ordinance Entitled RACINE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE adopted December 2, 1969, found on pages 185 to 232 of the OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE RACINE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE YEAR 1969 as recodified May 28, 1991, by Ordinance 91-196.

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Racine ordains as follows: Amend the Racine County Zoning Ordinance and change the zoning district for the following described lands from A-1 General Farming District I to A-2 General Farming & Residential District II

THAT PART OF the West one-half (1/2) of the Southeast onequarter (1/4) of Section Four (4), Township Three (3) North, Range Twenty-one (21) East, bounded as follows:

BEGIN at the South 4 corner of said Section 4;

RUN THENCE North 1437.36 feet on the North-South 1/4 line of said Section;

THENCE South 87°48'40" East, 1320.97 feet to the East line of the West ½ of the Southeast (¼) of Section 4;

THENCE South $0^{\circ}04$ ' West 1429.69 feet on the East line of the West ½ of the Southeast ¼ of said Section to the South line of said Section;

THENCE North 88°08'10" West 1319.05 feet on the South line of said Section to the point of beginning.

SAID LAND being in the Town of Yorkville

EXCEPTING THEREFROM land conveyed to Racine County for highway purposes by Conveyance dated October 2, 1967, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Racine County, Wisconsin, on October 5, 1967, in Volume 961 of Records at page 121, as Document No. 829210.

The official Racine County Zoning Map is hereby amended to conform to this ordinance.

The Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit duplicate copies of this ordinance by registered mail to the Yorkville Town Clerk within seven (7) days after this ordinance is adopted.
