SEC. 5-4(b) Issuance of citations; enforcement

(b) In addition to law enforcement officers, the following officials of the county are hereby authorized to issue citations for the provisions of this Code or ordinances specified below. Such officials may delegate this authority to designated employees:

Violation of provisions in chapter 16, article IV

Violations of provisions in chapter 14

Violations of provisions in chapters 12.5 and 18-210

Violation of provisions in chapter 16, article VI

Violations of section 11-20

Enforcement officer

Director of public works, administrator of Ridgewood Health Care Center Public works director

Zoning administrator

Director of public works

School attendance officer appointed pursuant to W.S.A.§ 118.16(1)(b)
