ORDINANCE NO. 2007-77

ORDINANCE BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTION OF CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE V OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SMOKING

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors do ordain as follows:

Part 1

Section 16-91 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to "county buildings" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-91. Definitions.

County buildings shall mean all buildings owned or leased by the County and operated by its employees. If only part of a building is leased to the County and operated by its employees, this ordinance shall apply only to those premises leased to the County, including common areas, and to the area within 25 feet of any entrance authorized for use by employees or customers of the County. This policy shall not apply to buildings which the County or any of its political subunits might own, but lease to other agents or to any facility which the County leases to provide offices or work sites for its employees. However, the corporation counsel shall contact all such lessors and lessees, informing them concerning both the state and County clean indoor air act and ordinance respectively, and encouraging them to voluntarily implement similar policies governing the use of the respective facilities they manage. No County political subunit nor any of its employees shall attempt to block or impede the implementation of any such policies provided they are written in accordance with this article. Additionally, any new leases or other types of contractual instruments entered into subsequent to the enactment of this article by the County or any of its political subunits shall incorporate the various smoking regulations stipulated within this article. This ordinance shall not invalidate any lease provision in a building leased in whole or in part to the County and operated by its employees, to the extent that any said provision is more restrictive to smoking than this ordinance. If any lease provision in any said building is less restrictive to smoking than this ordinance, then this ordinance shall apply.

Part 2

Section 16-93 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to violations and penalties is hereby amended to read as follows:

 Sec. 16-93. Violation; penalties.

 Smoking in areas where smoking is not permitted under the provisions of this article, or disposing of smoking materials other than in designated receptacles for said materials in areas where smoking is permitted under this article, is a violation of this article. Any person who smokes in an area covered by this article where smoking is not permitted, or who disposes of smoking materials other than in designated receptacles for said materials in violation of this article, in areas where smoking is permitted under this article, shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than ten dollars (\$10.00) together with assessments and costs of prosecution. In default of payment thereof, the violator may be held in contempt of court and imprisoned in sanctioned to the County jail until paid, but not more than thirty (30) days for a period determined by the court.

Part 3

Section 16-95 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to prohibition is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-95. Prohibition.

(a) Except as specifically provided in section 16-96, no person may smoke in the following places:

(1) Any enclosed, indoor area located within any building owned <u>or leased</u> by the County and operated by its employees. This includes all elevators, public lobbies, corridors, waiting rooms, dining areas, restrooms, stairwells, auditoriums, conference, <u>meeting</u>, and/or training and testing rooms, offices, jury assembly and deliberation rooms, courtroom and other associated hearing, counseling and waiting areas, garage and shop work areas, meeting facilities specifically designated in W.S.A. s101.123, including educational facilities, inpatient health facilities, community based residential facilities, restaurants, retail establishments including stores, shops or concession sales outlets, and all other enclosed, indoor area facilities contained within <u>buildings owned or leased by the County</u>. <u>If only part of a building is leased to the County and operated by its employees, the area where smoking is prohibited also includes common areas within the building, and the area within 25 feet of any entrance authorized for use by employees or customers of the County.</u>

(2) Any County owned motor vehicle and any means of public conveyance owned or leased by the County and operated by its employees.
