PLANNING COMMITTEE TO REZONE FROM A-2 GENERAL FARMING & RESIDENTIAL

DIST. II TO R-2 SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL DIST. (SEWERED)

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Racine ordains as follows: Amend the Racine County Zoning Ordinance and change the zoning district for the following described lands from A-2 General Farming & Residential Dist. II to R-2 Suburban Residential Dist.

A TRACT OF LAND BEING PART OF the southwest 4 of the northwest ⁴ of Section 22, Town 4 North, Range 20 East, in the Town of Norway, County of Racine, State of Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

COMMENCE at the west 4 corner of said Section;

THENCE north 00°00'44" west for a distance of 92.48 feet, along the west line of said 4 Section, to the point of beginning;

THENCE north 00°00'44" west for a distance of 245.62 feet, continuing along said west line, to a point;

THENCE north 88°00'02" east for a distance of 354.25 feet, to a point;

THENCE south 00°00'44" east for 246.54 feet, parallel to the west line of said 4 Section, to a point;

THENCE south 88°05'59" west for a distance of 354.22 feet, to the point of beginning.

CONTAINING 2.0000 acres of land.

DEDICATING the westerly 33.00 feet for public road purposes.

The official Racine County Zoning Map is hereby amended to conform to this ordinance.
