AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND that Certain Ordinance Entitled RACINE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE adopted December 2, 1969, found on pages 185 to 232 of the OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE RACINE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE YEAR 1969 as recodified May 28, 1991, by Ordinance 91-196.

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Racine ordains as follows: Amend the Racine County Zoning Ordinance and change the zoning district for the following described lands from M-2 General Industrial District to M-3 Heavy Industrial District

THAT PART OF the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 20 East, bounded as follows:

BEGIN AT A POINT 825 feet North and 1011 feet East of the North and South $\frac{1}{4}$ line of said Section;

RUN THENCE East 326.2 feet;

THENCE North 879.86 feet to the center line of State Trunk Highway 11;

THENCE Westerly along said center line of said highway 327.9 feet;

THENCE South 892.36 feet to the place of beginning.

EXCEPTING therefrom the land conveyed by Warranty Deed recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Racine County, Wisconsin, in Volume 791 of Records, Page 180, as Document No. 756860.

SAID land being in the Town of Dover, County of Racine, State of Wisconsin,

CONTAINING 5.654 acres, more or less.

The official Racine County Zoning Map is hereby amended to conform to this ordinance.

The Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit duplicate copies of this ordinance by registered mail to the Dover Town Clerk within seven (7) days after this ordinance is adopted.
