ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE AMENDING SECTION 13.54 PROHIBITIONS; EXCEPTIONS (1), (3),& (5) & REPEALING (9) & AMENDING SECTION 13.55 RESTRICTIONS OF CHAPTER 13, OPEN BURNING, RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND that Certain Ordinance Entitled OPEN BURNING adopted July 25, 1989, found on pages 68 & 69 of the OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE RACINE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, APRIL 1989, as recodified May 28, 1991, by Ordinance 91-196.

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows: Amend Section 13-Open Burning to read as follows:

Amend the following paragraphs of Section 13-54 Prohibitions; exceptions as follows:

- (1) Outdoor fires for cooking, ceremonies and recreation. Such fires may not burn plastic, rubber, asphalt, oily substances, business refuse or any materials that will create dense smoke or cause a nuisance.
- (3) Burning of trees, wood or brush in Department of Natural Resources approved air curtain destructors or by such other methods approved by the Department of Natural Resources.
- (5) Fires set for the practice and instruction of firemen firefighters or testing of firefighting equipment.
- (9) Repeal this paragraph in its entirety.

Amend the following paragraphs of Section 13.55 Restrictions as follows:

- (c) Exceptions (7), and (8) and (9) contained in Section 13.54 are permitted only between the hours of 12:00 noon and 7:00 p.m. prevailing time.
- (d) On such days when atmospheric conditions are unacceptable for burning, the Department of Natural Resources will issue an air pollution advisory. When such an advisory has been issued, all local fire protection agencies shall not grant permission to burn under exceptions (5), (6), (7), and (8) and (9). Approval is subject to local and state fire protection regulations.
- (e) Certain municipalities may have more restrictive hours for open burning than those listed herein. In such cases, the more restrictive provisions shall apply.

The Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit duplicate copies of this ordinance by registered mail to all affected Town Clerks within seven (7) days after this ordinance is adopted.
