ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE AMENDING SECTION 20-32 MEMBERSHIP OF CHAPTER 20, ZONING, RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Racine ordains as follows:

 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND that certain ordinance entitled RACINE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE adopted December 2, 1969, found on pages 185 to 232 of the OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE RACINE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE YEAR 1969 as recodified May 28, 1991, by ordinance 91-196

AMEND SEC. 20-32 MEMBERSHIP AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 20-32.Membership

(a) The Board of Adjustment shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the chairman of the board of supervisors County Executive and confirmed by the Board of Supervisors. The members of the Board of Adjustment shall all reside within the county and outside of the limits of incorporated cities and villages; provided, however, that no two (2) members shall reside in the same town.

RENUMBER (b), (c), (d), and (e) as (c), (d), (e), and (f) respectively.

CREATE SEC. 20-32(b)

(a) The County Executive shall appoint, for staggered three (3)-year terms, two (2) alternate members of the Board of Adjustment, who are subject to the approval of the County Board. Annually, the County Executive of the County Board shall designate one of the alternate members as the first alternate with the other as second alternate. The first alternate shall act, with full power, only when a member of the Board of Adjustment refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or when a member is absent. The second alternate shall act only when the first alternate refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or is absent, or if more than one member of the Board of Adjustment refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or is absent.

CREATE SEC. 20-32(g)

 (g) If a quorum is present, the Board of Adjustment may take action under this Section by a majority vote of the members present.

The Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit duplicate copies of this ordinance by registered mail to all official Town Clerks within seven (7) days after this ordinance is adopted.
