16 AMEND SEC. 20-32 MEMBERSHIP AS FOLLOWS:

18 Sec. 20-32.Membership

19 (a) The Board of Adjustment shall consist of five (5) members
20 appointed by the ~~chairman of the board of supervisors~~ County
21 Executive and confirmed by the Board of Supervisors. The members
22 of the Board of Adjustment shall all reside within the county and
23 outside of the limits of incorporated cities and villages;
24 provided, however, that no two (2) members shall reside in the same
25 town.
26

27 RENUMBER (b), (c), (d), and (e) as (c), (d), (e), and (f) respectively.
28

29 CREATE SEC. 20-32(b)

30 (a) The County Executive shall appoint, for staggered three
31 (3)-year terms, two (2) alternate members of the Board of
32 Adjustment, who are subject to the approval of the County Board.
33 Annually, the County Executive of the County Board shall designate
34 one of the alternate members as the first alternate with the other
35 as second alternate. The first alternate shall act, with full
36 power, only when a member of the Board of Adjustment refuses to
37 vote because of a conflict of interest or when a member is absent.
38 The second alternate shall act only when the first alternate
39 refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or is absent, or
40 if more than one member of the Board of Adjustment refuses to vote
41 because of a conflict of interest or is absent.
42

43 CREATE SEC. 20-32(g)

44 (g) If a quorum is present, the Board of Adjustment may take
45 action under this Section by a majority vote of the members
46 present.
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49 The Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit duplicate copies of
50 this ordinance by registered mail to all official Town Clerks
51 within seven (7) days after this ordinance is adopted.
