**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-130** 

RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF A KNOWLES-NELSON STEWARDSHIP LOCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT THROUGH THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (WDNR) FOR A CANOE/KAYAK LAUNCH WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ROCHESTER AT CASE EAGLE PARK

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

WHEREAS, Racine County and the Village of Waterford are mutually interested in partnering to develop lands for public outdoor aquatic recreation within the Village of Waterford and Case Eagle Park; and

WHEREAS, the construction of two (2) canoe / kayak launches will enhance and expand the nature-based outdoor recreation opportunities within the western portion of Racine County and the Village of Waterford; and

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources offers stewardship grants which fund development projects for nature-based outdoor recreation, such as a non-motorized boat launches; and

WHEREAS, this project will promote public health, comfort, convenience, necessity and public welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works, Parks, and Facilities Committee recognizes the need for enhancing outdoor recreation opportunities within the Village and within Racine County parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County, through the Public Works and Development Services Department, requests grant funding assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the "Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Grant Program." to submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for naturebased outdoor recreation purposes; to sign documents; to undertake, direct and complete an approved stewardship grant, and to submit reimbursement claims along with supporting documentation within six (6) months of project completion date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Racine County will meet the financial obligations of the planning project, including timely publication of the results, and meet the financial obligations under the stewardship grant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Clerk shall forward a copy of this resolution to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the Village of Waterford Clerk.
