**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

## INFORMATION ONLY

WHEREAS, Racine County has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$49,035.00 by the State of Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance, under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program, to help Racine County and local law enforcement agencies pay the costs of Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) and Partnership (CIP) training, including helping participating law enforcement agencies to defray the overtime and other additional costs associated with sending officers to such training; and

**WHEREAS**, recognizing CIT as a proven technique for law enforcement personnel who deal with persons in psychiatric crisis, Racine County has provided some funding for CIT training in every budget since 2009; and

WHEREAS, Racine County has developed a countywide CIT training collaboration that includes the Offices of the County Executive and Corporation Counsel, the Sheriff's Office, and the Human Services Department; the Police Departments of Racine, Villages of Caledonia and Mount Pleasant, Office of Public Defender; Division of Community Corrections; NAMI Racine County; Wheaton Franciscan Health Care; Racine County SAIL Program; Racine Friendship Clubhouse; Racine Area Veterans, Inc.; and Gateway Technical College; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of this grant would permit county law enforcement agencies, including the Racine County Sheriff's Office, to send more officers to CIT training without negative budgetary repercussions; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of this grant is in the interest of Racine County and fully consistent with public safety and with the needs and concerns of its citizens, especially those who are experiencing serious mental health issues; and

WHEREAS, no county match is required for the grant.
