RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING RELOCATION AND ACQUISITION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY AND EASEMENTS FOR A HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ON COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY "X" IN THE VILLAGES OF MOUNT PLEASANT AND ELMWOOD PARK AND THE CITY OF RACINE, RACINE COUNTY

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Public Works Committee authorizes the proper improvement and maintenance of County Trunk Highway "X" requiring certain relocation or changes and authorizes the acquisition of additional right-of-way and easements along that portion of County Trunk Highway "X" (Taylor Avenue) from County Trunk Highway "Y" (Meachem Road) to State Highway 11 (Durand Avenue) in the Villages of Mount Pleasant and Elmwood Park and the City of Racine.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that under the authority granted by sections 32.05, 83.07, and 83.08 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Racine County Board of Supervisors authorizes County Trunk Highway "X" to be relocated and that right-of-ways be acquired, in accordance with the relocation order attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", and the plan attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B". A copy of the relocation order and plan shall be filed with the Racine County Clerk within twenty (20) days after its issue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Racine County Board of Supervisors authorize Corporation Counsel to prepare a contract with necessary and appropriate terms and conditions to facilitate this improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Executive, the County Clerk and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

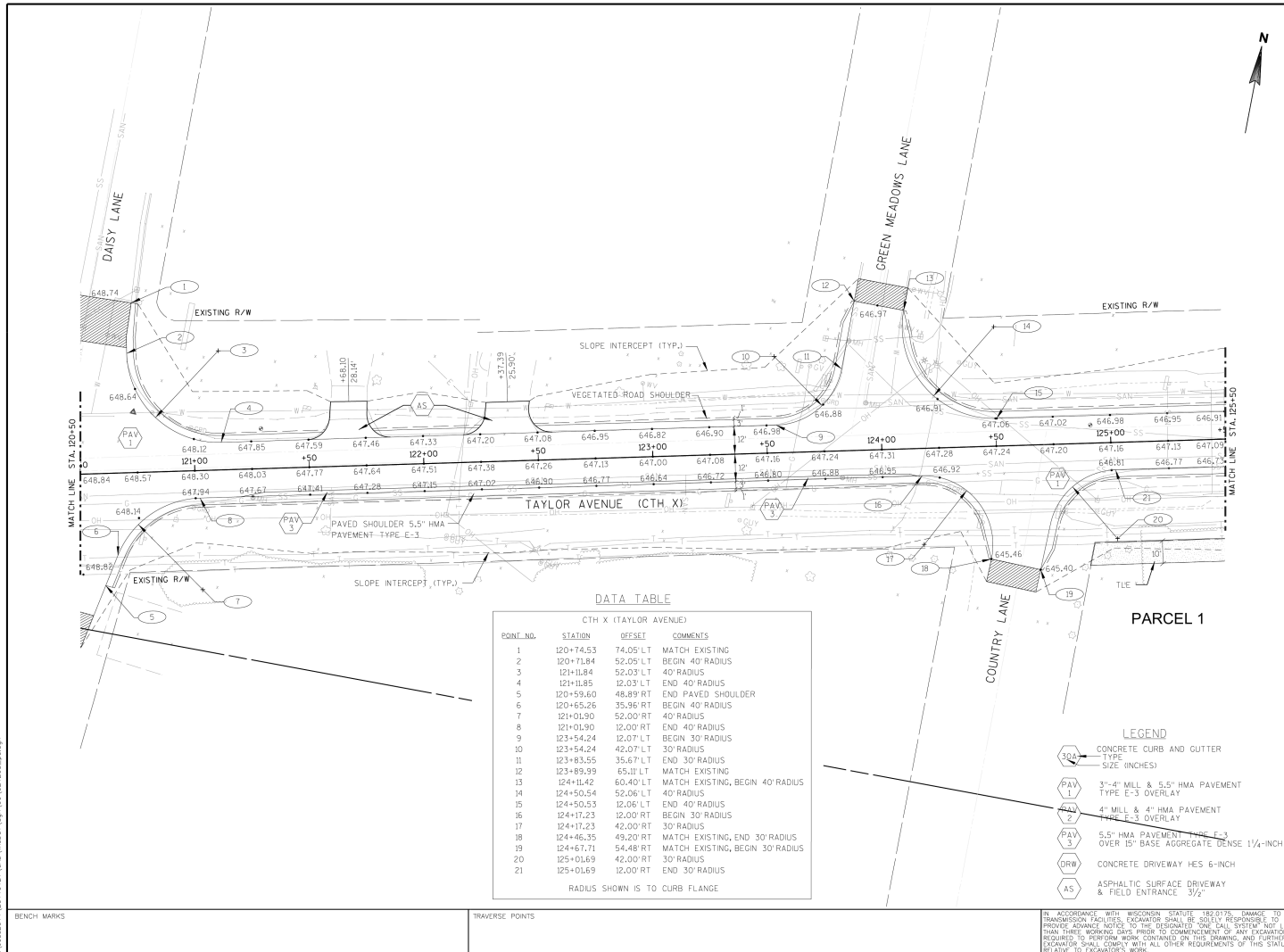

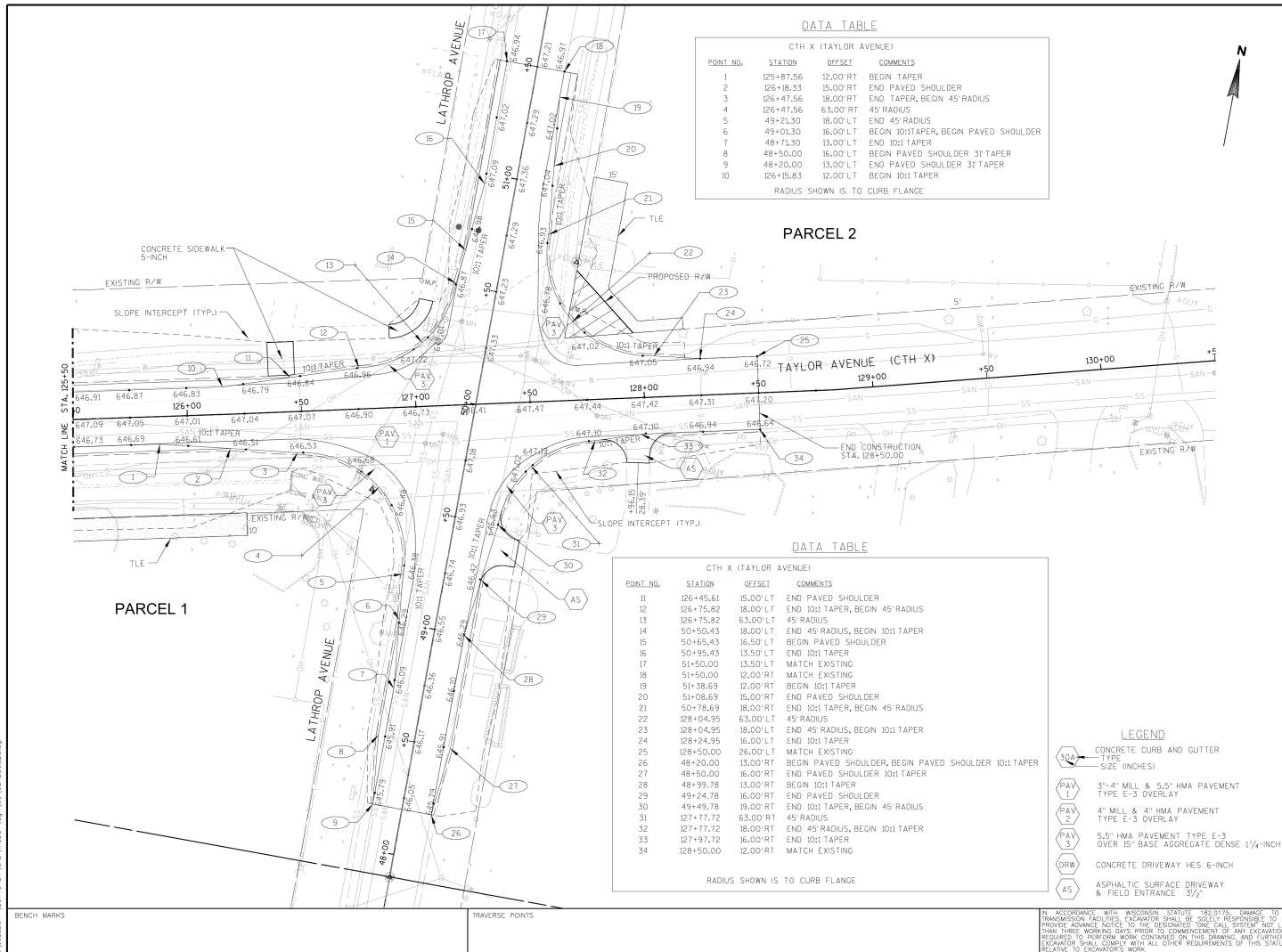
