

RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE RACINE COUNTY REVOLVING LOAN FUND PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

WHEREAS, the county's Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) originated from funds awarded to the County from the Wisconsin Department of Commerce (DOC) to assist specific businesses that were expanding; and

WHEREAS, as those dollars are repaid, some go into the RLF loan fund to be relent to other businesses in accordance with the regulations set forth in the Manual; and

WHEREAS, a summary of the current status of this loan fund is below:

Available for lending: Over \$500,00
 Total Investments: \$84.3 Million
 Total RLF Participation through fund: \$11.4 Million
 Total Loan Balances Currently: \$7.8 Million

WHEREAS, as of July 1, 2013, the Wisconsin Department of Administration (DOA) – Division of Housing has replaced the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation in the administration of CDBG applications and contract management activities, including RLF's: and

WHEREAS, DOA is requiring changes to the RLF Policy Manuals to ensure they are in compliance with program regulations; and

WHEREAS, the following is a summary of the key changes required by DOA which have been incorporated into the manual:

Low and Moderate Income (LMI) Requirements The new language in the manual details what jobs are considered

made available to LMI individuals and describes how to meet the LMI requirements of the program. Specifically, new documentation is being required of loan recipients to demonstrate that at least 51% of interviewees for created employment positions are made available to LMI individuals.

2. Federal Anti-Piracy Requirement

Language was required to be added to address anti-pirating under the Code of Federal Regulations, which does not allow funds to be used to relocate a business from one labor market to another resulting in job loss from the existing area.
