WHEREAS, Racine County has offered to provide 12 inch thick concrete materials from a job site located at the Waukegan Airport in Waukegan, Illinois to residents in Racine County that will be broken into large chunks for placement along shorelines; and

WHEREAS, the materials provided will be free for residents to take; however there are costs associated with hauling the material from Illinois to Racine County; and

WHEREAS, Racine County fleet trucks are neither equipped nor allowed to cross state lines; therefore a local hauler is needed to assist with the hauling effort; Jung Trucking has agreed to assist and will be required to show proof of insurance and that all drivers are licensed to haul across state lines; and

WHEREAS, beginning the week of August 2, 2016, there will be two (2) phases of hauling to bring the concrete materials into Racine County into close proximity of several properties that have a need for new or additional shoreline protection; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of Phases 1 and 2 will not exceed \$35,000.00; Racine County has committed this portion in an effort to help protect shoreline properties; and

WHEREAS, the initial material will be dropped off at the abandoned fire station along Sheridan Road in Mt. Pleasant as that area is "ground zero" for the massive erosion issues: and

WHEREAS, the material to be provided will not solve the erosion problems; rather, it is only a temporary measure to slow down the rate of erosion at the toe of the bluff;

WHEREAS, property owners are then required to contract on their own with qualified individuals who can place the material along their shorelines as Racine County will not place materials on private properties; and

WHEREAS, not all property owners will receive the full amount of concrete they are requesting but most property owners should get a fair amount of material; and

WHEREAS, Racine County will be held harmless by the Village of Mt. Pleasant for any claims about road damages related to the hauling of concrete material; and

WHEREAS, any unused funds for the hauling will return to contingent fund; and

WHEREAS, the remaining \$50,000.00 of the transfer will be used to cover the costs of economic support studies including: cash flow potential on downtown development, Rails to Trails project, joint County-City of Burlington study to replace Western Racine County Service Center, and the future expansion of mental health services.
