WHEREAS, in 2003, the Wisconsin Department of Commerce (now known as the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation--WEDC) awarded Racine County a \$4,000,000 grant, that, in turn, was loaned to Midwest Airlines, Inc. and Skyway Airlines, Inc. (the "Company") for a business retention project in Milwaukee County. Racine County, Milwaukee County and the Company, entered into an agreement that provided for the repayment of this loan, 50 percent of which was to be used to establish a revolving loan fund (RLF) that would be available to local businesses. Due to the change in ownership of the Company, loan payments are now being made by Frontier Airlines owned by Republic Airlines; and

WHEREAS, these funds, combined with the Racine County budget appropriations - for 2012, the County of Racine has budgeted \$1 million for a new Racine County Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) with the intent to augment this fund with an additional \$1 million annually for the subsequent three years - are intended to be used to provide low-interest loans to local businesses; and

**WHEREAS,** the Racine County Economic Development Corporation (RCEDC) administers the RLF on behalf of Racine County; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this Policies and Procedures Manual is to set forth the criteria for future loans from the RLF.
