RESOLUTION BY FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE ESTABLISHING THE TOTAL ANNUAL COMPENSATION OF THE COUNTY CLERK, THE COUNTY TREASURER, AND THE REGISTER OF DEEDS FOR THE YEARS 2013, 2014, 2015 AND 2016

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors, that the total annual compensation for stated county elected officials under Wis. Stat. § 59.22(1) shall be as follows, effective on the first day of a term of office that begins after the date of this Resolution:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned county elected officials are entitled to participate in the Wisconsin Retirement System in accordance with law and the County shall pay only its share of contributions required by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforementioned county elected officials are entitled to participate in the County's health insurance program subject to the terms and conditions of the program, which may be modified from time to time, under the same terms and conditions as the health insurance coverage offered to non-represented managerial county employees who are not law enforcement managerial employees or non-represented managerial employees described in Wis. Stat. §111.70(1)(mm)2.

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31 **WHEREAS**, the Board desires to establish the total annual compensation for  
32 county elected officials, which is separate and distinct from the fringe benefits offered by  
33 the County to elected officials, and which fringe benefits are subject to increase or  
34 decrease during the officer's term at the discretion of the Board and in accordance with  
35 state and federal law; and

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37 **WHEREAS**, as part of the County's fringe benefit program, county elected  
38 officials may participate in the Wisconsin Retirement System in accordance with state  
39 law; and

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41 **WHEREAS**, as part of the County's fringe benefit program, county elected  
42 officials may elect to receive health insurance coverage under the same terms and  
43 conditions as the health insurance coverage offered to non-represented managerial  
44 county employees who are not law enforcement managerial employees or non-  
45 represented managerial employees described in Wis. Stat. § 111.70(1)(mm)2; and

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5 **WHEREAS**, the recommendation came to the Finance and Human Resource  
6 Committee by the County Clerk, Register of Deeds and County Treasurer, in person, to  
7 have their salaries remain at the 2012 rate for the years 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016  
8 and be as follows:

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20 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.22(1), the Board must establish the total  
21 annual compensation for services to be paid to county elected officials (other than  
22 supervisors and circuit judges) prior to the earliest time for filing nomination papers for  
23 the county elective office; and

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25 **WHEREAS**, the individuals elected to the positions of County Clerk, County  
26 Treasurer, and Register of Deeds in November 2012 will hold office for terms of four  
27 years; and

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29 **WHEREAS**, Resolution 99-81 established the principle that the salaries of these  
30 elected county officials should be set and maintained at levels in keeping with the  
31 responsibilities and duties of their respective offices.

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
