6 **WHEREAS**, Racine County has entered into an Agreement with the Wisconsin
7 Department of Transportation (State Construction Project I.D. 3755-02-00) for funding to
8 reconstruct "CTH" D, Washington Avenue, from Heritage Road to State Street in the Village of
9 Rochester; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Federal policy, Wis Stats. Section 84.01(35) and the Wisconsin Department
12 of Transportation Administrative Code Trans 75 – Bikeways and Sidewalks in Highway Projects,
13 requires that bicycle and pedestrian accommodations be considered on projects that involve
14 federal funds; and
