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WHEREAS, the Clinical Director position will require a unique set of qualifications, which include:

- State of Wisconsin credentials in all of the following areas: Licensed Clinical Social Worker Supervisor, Licensed Clinical Substance Abuse Counselor, and State of Wisconsin Intoxicated Driver Program certification;
- Previous experience in the management of a mental health and substance abuse clinic;
- Knowledge of Racine County Community Mental Health systems, Racine County Court System, Racine County Intoxicated Driver Program, and Racine County mental health provider network;
- Experience developing partnerships with public health agencies and other agencies that have a prevention focus, early intervention and disease management and/or mental health or substance abuse services focus;
- Ability to respond to crises and to make appropriate judgments as to resolution;
- Understanding of Medicaid, Medicare and private insurance billing functions; and
- Experience in the development and the implementation of ongoing programs of marketing, outreach and public education to all target populations; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mary Jane Whitmore, MSW, LCSW, CSAC, ICS, IDP-AT, owner of Racine Psychological Services, Inc., holds the credentials and qualifications outlined above and has demonstrated those attributes during her 39 years of experience in mental health and substance abuse counseling; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Whitmore and Racine Psychological Services, Inc. have had a long and mutually beneficial relationship with the Racine County Human Services Department and have provided, for many years, excellent mental health and substance abuse services to Racine County residents.; and

WHEREAS, Racine County's excellent experience in collaborating with Ms. Whitmore and Racine Psychological Services, Inc. constitutes a valid reason for the waiver of bidding requirements for selection for Clinical Director services in a new Behavioral Health Clinic; and

WHEREAS, as a practical matter, there is no other source available for the required services, because no other individual or firm has the unique skills and qualifications required of a Clinical Director, or the requisite familiarity with Racine County's mental health and substance abuse services, as well as the Racine County criminal justice system.
